Guitarist Alan Goldspiel in Concert October 23

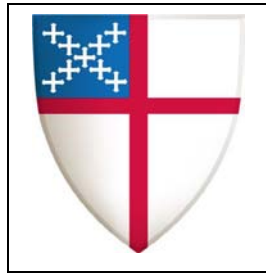


ALAN GOLDSPIEL has performed world premieres at New York's Carnegie and CAMI Halls and has been featured on NPR radio stations from coast to coast. He is the recipient of the Alabama State Council on the Arts 2016-2017 Artist Fellowship Award for artistic excellence as well as professional commitment and maturity – awarded to outstanding individual artists from Alabama who create important works of art and make valuable contributions to the entire state. His music has been performed at national and international events including the conferences of the North American Saxophone Alliance, National Association of Composers, and International Clarinet Association. Dr. Goldspiel received the 2014 Alabama Music Teachers Association Composition Commission and he was a 2013 recipient of the Escape to Create Residency in Seaside, Florida. The concert will be at 4 p.m. in the worship space.

3. Mention on social media some great ministry you are involved in with your church.
4. Make a cover image that reflects your faith.
5. Share every video Presiding Bishop Curry makes on every platform you're on.

6. Like and share others' posts about God and church.
7. Friend and follow others in your church and diocese.
8. Check in on social media every time you come to church.
9. Use the hashtag #episcopal to find other Episcopalians on Twitter or Instagram.
10. Post a photo of you with some of your favorite church friends at coffee hour.

Invite

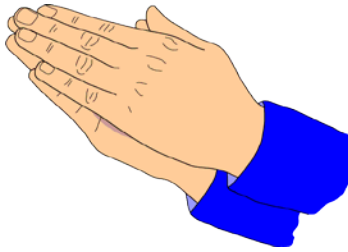
11. Post the times of your church's service on social media and invite your friends to join you.
