A Message from Margaret,

The celebrated historian Sister Wendy Beckett, in her book, *Nativity*, has written lovely accompanying text fitted to paintings on biblical themes from late antiquity to the late fifteenth century. Of the Visitation of Mary and Elizabeth,

commenting on a page from *The Blessed Virgin Mary's Book of Hours*, attributed to Jacobus Coen (15th century), she writes: "Mary did not ask for any sign from the angel: she believed with pure faith. But she was given what she had not requested, and the sign was one that paralleled her own miracle, but at a distance.

"Her cousin Elizabeth had grown old without a child, thought then to be a sign of God's displeasure, and an abiding grief for the deprived couple. But Elizabeth is already six months pregnant, the angel tells Mary (although, tactfully, he chooses not to tell her that her cousin's husband, Zechariah, has been unable to believe his own angelic message, and has been struck dumb for a time in consequence)."

We are told that Mary arose with haste and set out to visit her cousin. Luke tells us that they met in Zechariah's house, but the artist, Coen, prefers to show them embracing in a fertile field. The landscape suggests an unsafe world; the surrounding hills look like frozen rockets, sharp and hostile-not unlike the mountains that, according to John the Baptizer, which would be made low (Isabel Anders). But the spot where the two women meet, Sister Wendy continues, they seem to call into being by their presence-the trees and the grasses. But the artist cannot portray the moment the babies encounter each other; we only know about it through Elizabeth's ecstatic report of the leap she feels within.

What a picture we have here, far removed from the worldly centers of power and prestige. Two pregnant women, of greatly differing age-one old, the other a teenager-and two very different circumstances. And words of wisdom pour from

their lips, resounding in their world—and tumbling all the way to our day and our seeking hearts:

The Mighty One has done great things for me, And holy is his name.

It is on this Sunday-Mary Sunday- along with holy Mary, in the presence of blessed Elizabeth, that we, too, lift our hearts and souls to magnify the Lord.
