He serves as an accompanist for numerous FSU ensembles, private instrumental and vocal music lessons, student recitals, and for the School of Theatre's recent productions of *Cabaret* and *Monty Python's Spamalot!* Andy currently studies classical piano with Dr. David Kalhous and was a finalist in the 2015 FSU Annual Piano Competition, focusing on the music of J.S. Bach.

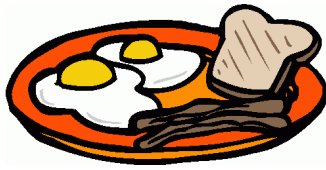
